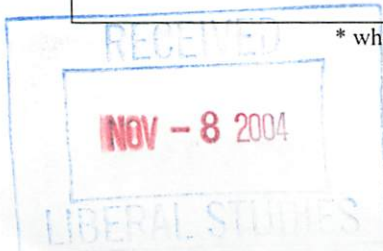

Part II: Description of Curriculum Change: Change of Prerequisites

New course description

1. **HPED 318: Preprofessional Experience I**

3c-01-1cr

Prerequisite: EDUC 242, HPED 216, Health and Physical Education majors only.

Students teach as assistants to a faculty member in two different activities, one in physical education (general education) and one in elementary physical education. Emphasizes unit development, class management, leadership skills, and evaluation.

Old course description

2. **HPED 318: Preprofessional Experience I**

3c-01-1cr

Prerequisite: Health and Physical Education majors only.

Students teach as assistants to a faculty member in two different activities, one in physical education (general education) and one in elementary physical education. Emphasizes unit development, class management, leadership skills, and evaluation.

Justification for the change

- Under the current curriculum, students seeking teaching certification in Health and Physical Education can take all their methods courses before being admitted to the College of Education. This has resulted in some students completing several credits before making application to the teacher education program. Consequently there is the possibility they will have completed nearly 90 credits before their prestudent teaching experience. Adding EDUC 242 as a prerequisite to HPED 318 will require students to follow a more logical sequence in the teacher education program. The recommended prerequisite of HPED 321 will be dropped as that course is no longer taught and has been replaced by HPED 216 Teaching Elementary Physical Education. The information taught in this class prepares the students for HPED 318 teaching experiences. Therefore, it will be changed from a recommended prerequisite to a required prerequisite.
