Catalog Description

THTR 350 Directing 3 credits 3 lecture hours 0 lab hours 3c-0l-2sh

Prerequisites: THTR 111, 240 or permission of instructor

An introduction to basic directing skills: casting, floor plans, blocking, rehearsal procedures, and the applications of scenes and character analysis. Students will prepare short scenes for class presentation.

Section 2: Summary of the proposed revision

The only change in this revision is a change of prerequisite.

Section 3: Justification/rationale for the revision

One of the previous prerequisites was THTR 110 Script Analysis. It has been replaced by THTR 111 Foundations of Theater that still has a major script analysis focus in this new course. Therefore, this course can readily serve as the preparation necessary in script analysis skills needed for THTR 350 Directing.
