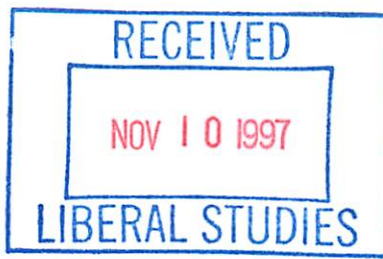

Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

Course prefix change from HE to FC

Convert the following HE course in the Family and Consumer Sciences Education content area to FC prefix:

HE 350 Teaching Family Life Education -to- FC 350 Teaching Family Life Education

FC 350 Teaching Family Life Education

3c-01-3sh

Prerequisites: FC 250, ED 242

Corequisite: EP 302

Emphasis on teaching family life education in home economics classrooms and through community organizations and agencies. Lessons are planned and implemented using a variety of instructional methods incorporated adaptations and modifications for special needs learners, basic skills, global concerns, and use of a problem-solving/decision-making approach. Planning of content, learning activities, instructional materials, and evaluation based on clearly stated objectives are emphasized. A microcomputer spreadsheet is utilized to manage a department budget and a gradebook. Participation in professional organization activities is expected.

Part III: Rationale for Change

These changes will align the course prefix , description, and title with the recent program name change. The current program title is Family and Consumer Sciences Education, formerly Home Economics Education. Please note, these changes effect only those courses that are exclusively Family and Consumer Sciences courses. All other HE prefix courses will be changed through the Child Development/Family Relations program.
