1. STATEMENT OF DELETION: The course RH 311 Rehabilitation of the Blind and Deaf will be deleted from the Rehabilitation program and University catalog.
2. JUSTIFICATION: With the approval of the attached program revision, this course will no longer be offered or required in the Rehabilitation program. One comprehensive course, RH 211 Medical Aspects of Rehabilitation, covering all medical conditions is sufficient to meet the needs of rehabilitation counselors. Combining RH 311 and RH 411 will permit room for a specific assessment course in the rehabilitation curriculum.
3. AFFECT ON PROGRAM: This course will be replaced by RH 211 Medical Aspects of Rehabilitation with the approval of the attached program revision.
