### Stimulus Package Passes House

The House passed [HR 1], the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 09 on January 28. The bill provides over \$140 billion in supplemental education funding for FY 09 and FY 10, and amends and creates certain education program authorities. The bill also includes amendments to the IRS Code of 1986 for school construction and modernization.

### Web Conference Schedule to Be Announced, Survey Available

A series of web conferences will be broadcast live from the GRC 2009 Proposal Development Workshop. To determine the selection, please complete this survey by Friday, February 13. The final web conference schedule will be published in the February 16 issue of GrantWatch and posted online. Completing the survey does not obligate you to register.

The web conference fee is \$180 for the first conference and \$130 for each additional conference. Institutions represented in person at the workshop will receive a 25 percent discount: \$117 for the first conference and \$94 for each additional conference.

(As an example, if your institution is not represented at the workshop and you would like to participate in four web conferences, the price will be \$180 + \$130 + \$130 + \$130, for a total price of \$570.)

### Senate Appropriations Committee Approves \$385 Billion Spending Measure

The Senate Appropriations Committee approved the \$385 billion spending portion of the Senate's economic recovery package (S 1) on January 28, 2009, with nearly \$7 billion more in discretionary spending than the House approved package and a somewhat different mix of higher education and research funding. The committee vote was 21 to 9, with four Republicans joining all Democrats in approving the package.

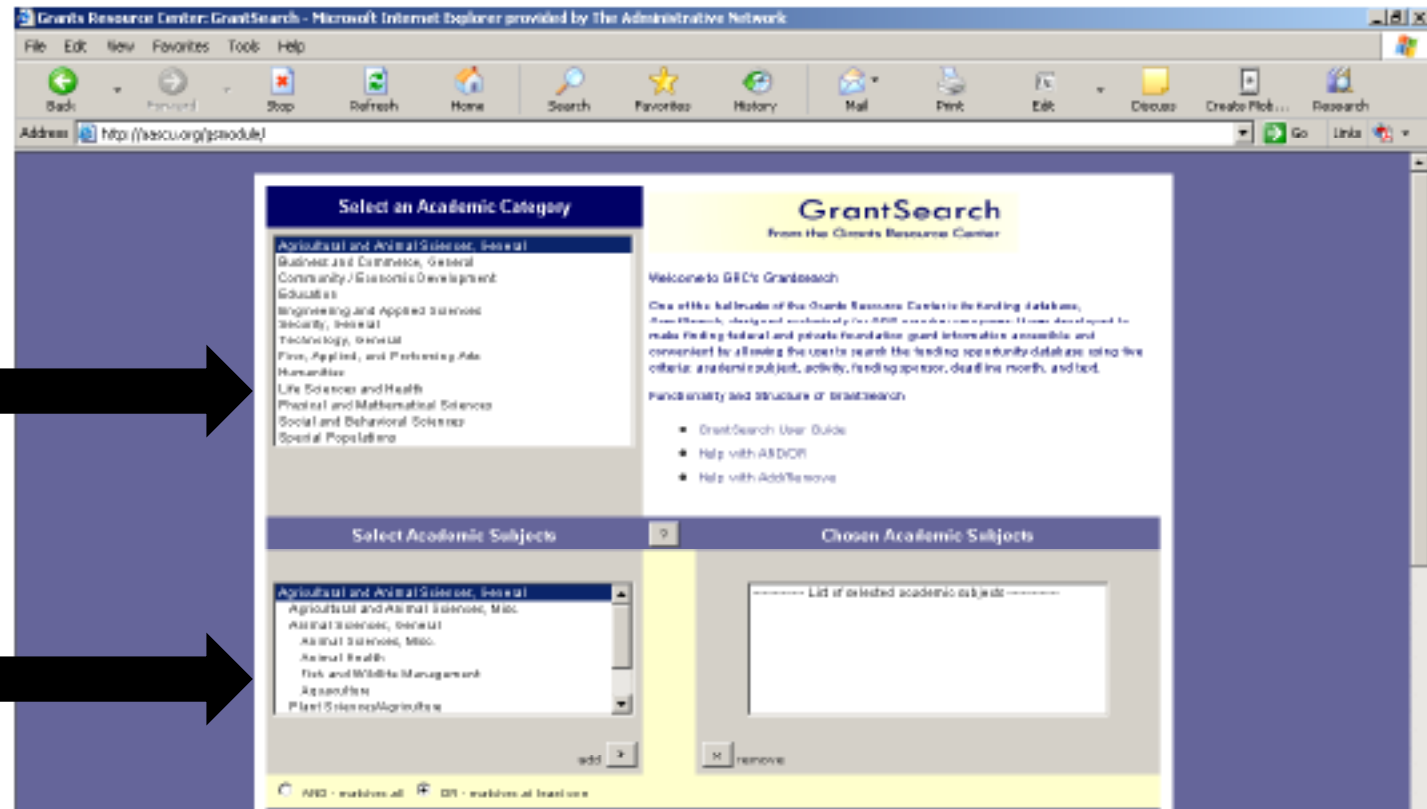

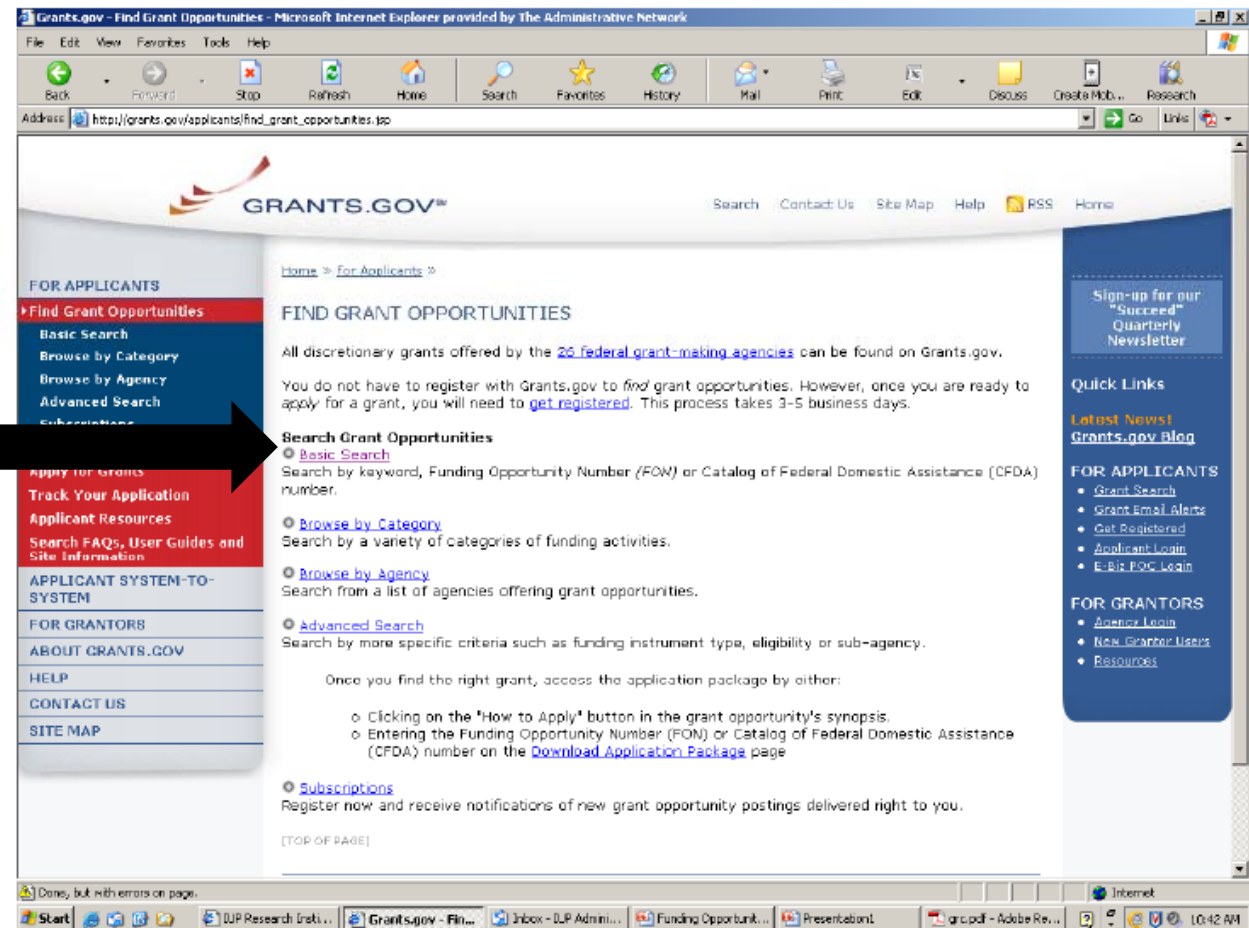

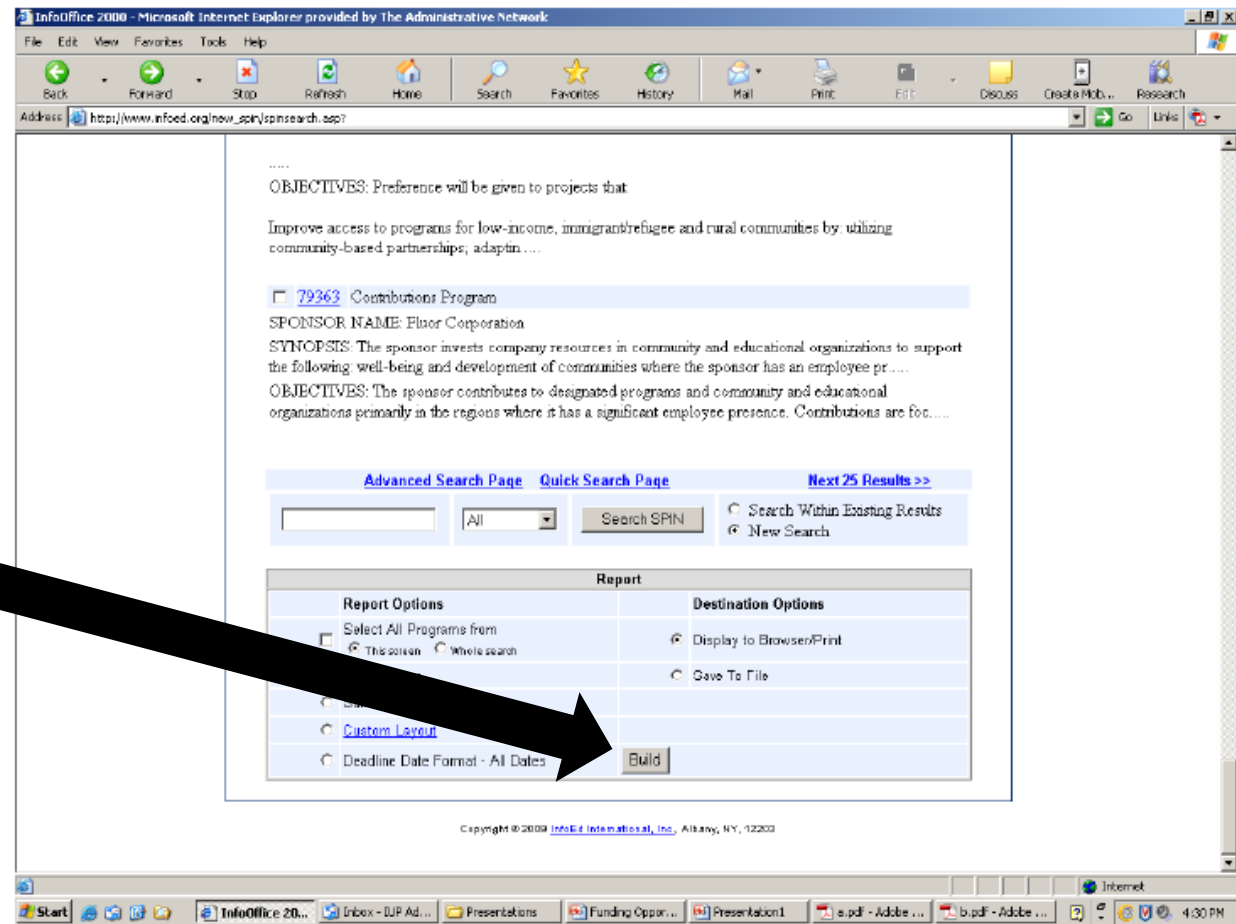
