 - On a Tickell/Fair motion the course was provisionally approved pending approval of the course revision proposal course
- b. 12-52 MATH 125 Calculus I for Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics, distance education
 - On a Tickell/Lewis motion the proposal was approved. Metz abstained.
- c. 12-23a BS Interior Design, program revision, catalog description change
 - On side by side, the old side needs to match the catalog in number of LS credits; plus remove nonwestern course
