Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

1. An exact statement of what is to be deleted

The Course ***GRMN 251 German III*** is to be deleted.

2. Justification/Rationale

There are two reasons for the deletion of ***GRMN 251 German III***:

a) ***GRMN 251 German III*** is being replaced by ***GRMN 201 Intermediate German***.

The German section of the Department of Foreign Languages redesigned the Elementary and Intermediate language sequence to be consistent within the Department of Foreign Languages. Three 4-credit courses are replacing the current four 3-credit courses. ***GRMN 251 German III*** is thus no longer needed. The new language sequence (GRMN 101, 102, and 201) was approved by Senate on May 1, 2012. ***GRMN 201 Intermediate German*** will be offered for the first time in Fall 2013, and ***GRMN 251 German III*** should not be listed any longer in the Undergraduate Catalog for the 2013-2014 academic year.

b) Deleting the course will free up the ***GRMN 251*** designation to be used for future new course development, if needed.

3. A description of how this change will affect existing courses, programs, etc. and how the deletion(s) will affect students currently enrolled in the program

This change will not affect other programs. It does affect one existing course, ***GRMN 252 German IV***, which is currently the second course in the Intermediate German sequence. ***GRMN 102 Elementary German*** students will now take ***GRMN 201 Elementary German*** as the next and only intermediate level course in the sequence, not ***GRMN 251 German III*** and ***GRMN 252 German IV***, which will be deleted as ***GRMN 201 Intermediate German*** is being phased in. ***GRMN 201 Intermediate German*** will be offered for the first time in Fall 2013. The deletion of ***GRMN 251 German III*** will not affect students currently enrolled in the program since they will have finished the class by the time of deletion.
