A substitute cross-cultural experience may be permitted with the academic advisor's recommendation. The foreign language requirement is a prerequisite to the foreign residency requirement.

A foreign student, registered as such at IUP, whose acquired native language is other than English and who demonstrates an acceptable proficiency in English, can meet the foreign language requirement by successful completion of an exemption examination in the acquired native language.
