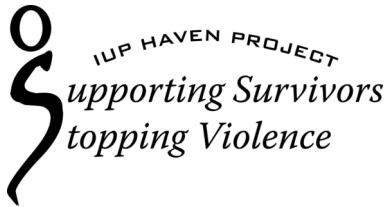

- **Offers crisis intervention**—The Haven Project at Alice Paul House includes a confidential 24-hour hotline to answer questions, address safety issues, offer shelter, and provide information and referral to other campus and community agencies.
- **Helps survivors with the criminal justice system**—by educating survivors about the system, accompanying survivors in filing criminal charges, assisting students in obtaining a Protection From Abuse order, preparing a Victim Impact Statement, and filing for restitution.
- **Meets with survivors on campus**—to answer questions and provide advocacy. Survivors, friends, and significant others of survivors can use this service.
- **Accompanies and provides support to survivors seeking medical services**—at local medical facilities, including IUP's Health Service, Adagio Health, and Indiana Regional Medical Center.
- **Assists survivors in filing for Crime Victims' Compensation**—which can compensate survivors for things such as loss of wages, ambulance bills, and/or unpaid medical bills as a result of a crime.
- **Assists survivors through the IUP Student Conduct process**—by educating survivors on the process, assisting survivors with filing Student Conduct charges, and/or accompanying survivors to Student Conduct proceedings.
- **Assists survivors with their safety and well-being**— by helping with new housing assignments, rearranging class schedules, obtaining coursework extensions, obtaining withdrawals from courses, and safety planning.
- **Offers counseling**—including individual and/or group counseling provided at IUP's Counseling Center or the Alice Paul House.
