The minor in psychology requires the completion of a minimum of 6 courses (i.e., a minimum of 18 credits) as follows. **A 2.0 GPA in all minor coursework is required for completion of the minor.** Grades in **ALL** PSYC courses taken will be used in calculating your minor GPA.

Required Courses:

PSYC 101: General Psychology (3sh; meets Liberal Studies Social Science requirement)

PSYC 280: Psychological Inquiry (3 sh; PSYC 290 may be substituted for PSYC 280)

Electives – Four other PSYC Courses (Minimum 12 sh – See the list below for choices)

³ Psychology laboratory courses may be taken with permission. Laboratory courses have MATH 217 and PSYC 290 as prerequisites.
