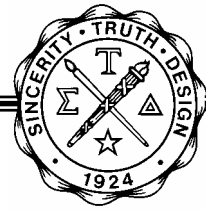

Scholarships, Internships, Grants, & Awards

Scholarships

Scholarships of up to \$4,000 are available in the following categories:

- Juniors who will be enrolled as college seniors in an English-related program during the scholarship term
- Seniors who will be enrolled as fifth year seniors or graduate students in an English-related program during the scholarship term
- Graduate students who will continue as such during the scholarship term
- Sigma Tau Delta members who will spend the scholarship term in a certified undergraduate program (that fosters the discipline of English) in a foreign country (study abroad scholarship)
- Sigma Tau Delta members who will attend a special summer program in the country where their chapter is located (this scholarship cannot be used toward a regular summer session in the student's home institution)
- Any Sigma Tau Delta member who will be enrolled in an English-related program during the scholarship term (open category: Regnery scholarship up to \$2,500; Sigma Tau Delta Scholar up to \$4,000; Regents' scholarships up to \$1000)

Internships

- Sigma Tau Delta co-sponsors internships with Regnery Publishing, Inc. These vary in length from six weeks to four months, with stipends of \$1,500 to \$4,000.

Grants

- Chapter Project Grants of up to \$300 are available to help Sigma Tau Delta chapters fund ongoing service projects.

Awards

- Writing Awards: Writing awards of up to \$300 are given for outstanding work published in the Sigma Tau Delta journals, *The Rectangle* and the *ΣΤΔ Review*.
- Beginning Teacher Awards: Teaching awards of up to \$2,000 are available each year to seniors who will begin teaching elementary, middle school, or high school English in the fall of the award term.
- Outstanding Chapter Awards: Outstanding chapter awards of up to \$350 are presented each year.
- Chapter Literary Arts Journal Awards: Chapter literary arts journal awards of up to \$500 are available for both printed and virtual publications.
- Convention Awards: Convention awards of up to \$200 are given annually for the best critical and best creative pieces presented at the ΣΤΔ Convention, and \$150 for the best presentation featuring the listed Common Reader.
- Scholarly Paper Awards: Scholarly paper awards of up to \$150 are given for the best student papers presented at non-Sigma Tau Delta professional conferences.
- Outstanding Chapter Sponsor Awards: Outstanding chapter sponsor awards of up to \$500 are presented each year.
- Best Website Awards: Awards of up to \$250 are presented each year to the best chapter websites and the best individual member websites.
- Best Scholarship Application Essay Awards: Best scholarship application essays are selected from among scholarship applications, with awards of up to \$100.
- Service Awards: Up to \$200 each, these awards honor chapters performing exemplary community service projects.
