The following document was emailed to faculty on October 24. Since then, an additional activity has been scheduled:

NEW: Blackboard Webinar/Conference Call - Tuesday, November 11

Members of the Online Learning Committee wanted to provide one last demo of Blackboard CE8 for anyone who was unable to attend the Blackboard visit in September. We realize this is late in the process, but Blackboard was willing to provide the demo free of charge. CE8 is a later version than faculty tested in the summer.

How: Log-in information will be distributed as soon as Blackboard provides it.

1. Last Vendor Visit - Moodlerooms
