Accomplish the next step toward becoming a registered dietitiannutritionist.

Complete the two-year IUP Dietitian-Nutritionist Program (DNP) through the Department of Food and Nutrition's Master of Science in Food and Nutrition. Enrolled students will earn their master's degree as well as earn eligibility to sit for the national examination for registered dietitiannutritionists upon successful program completion.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

For convenience, all curriculum-based master's courses are 100 percent online with both synchronous and asynchronous interactions with faculty and peers.

Enrolled Students come to campus 1-2 times through the program to participate in simulation experiences and networking related to the field experience.
