Welcome to the new academic year!

President Driscoll cannot be with us today and asked that I share some information on his behalf. At the opening day event, you heard that he has established a new set of university goals. They will be sent in a communication sometime next week, but he did ask me to share the seven goals.

- 1. Keep every student who comes to IUP. (Be an exceptionally student-centered university.)
- 2. Grow market share in traditional market.
- 3. Educate other student groups (open new markets).
- 4. Grow IUP's reputation.
- 5. Engage the (internal and external) IUP team in realizing the vision.
- 6. Find alternate revenue streams to support work.
- 7. Focus resources on the highest priorities to ensure a sustainable, thriving future.

These goals were approved by the Council of Trustees at their September 7, 2023, meeting.

The launch of the new academic year felt great! I'm seeing so much student, faculty, and staff energy. Thank you for this.

The fall freeze date is Monday, September 18 at 3:00 p.m. We are still enrolling students until then. The numbers are looking good. The freshman class is a good size, and our retention numbers are up.

As you know, we have a Liberal Studies Workgroup that has been working toward a revised framework for our general education curriculum. This group has developed four draft models

and is doing an incredible job of soliciting feedback through poster session engagement. There is one more poster session scheduled for tomorrow at 11:10 a.m. in the Blue Room of Sutton. I encourage you to take the opportunity to participate.

Our migration from the iWiki to Curriculog has been a success, as the first four proposals have moved through the approval process to APSCUF Rep Council. One of the key changes with this migration is that the proposals must be approved by December of 2023 in order for the curriculum change to be published in the 2024-2025 undergraduate and graduate catalogs. Proposals may still move through the approval process during the spring 2024 semester, but these curriculum changes will not be published in the 24-25 catalogs.
