

Alcohol & Cannabis (Marijuana) Sanctions

Below are the minimum sanctions for both alcohol and cannabis (marijuana) policy violations for behavior that occurs **on or off campus**. These sanctions are progressive and cumulative.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disciplinary Probation for one calendar year: \$150 fine • Alcohol Tobacco and Other Drug BASICS: \$35 fee 	First Violation

Second Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extended Disciplinary Probation for one calendar year (or remainder of career): \$175 fine • Counseling Center Individual Assessment: \$45 fee • Forfeiture of right to move off campus for an additional year

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stayed Suspension for one calendar year: \$200 fine • Stayed Removal from housing for one calendar year: \$175 fine • Proof of Treatment from an off campus licensed drug or alcohol treatment facility 	Third Violation

Fourth Violation	<p>Or first violation of possession of 30 or more grams of cannabis (marijuana) or sharing/furnishing/distributing alcohol, drugs, or possession/use of drugs other than cannabis (marijuana)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspension for one calendar year: \$300 fine • Removal from housing • Proof of Treatment from an off campus licensed drug or alcohol treatment facility

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspension or Expulsion 	Fifth Violation

<p>Students must notify the Office of Student Conduct 24 hours before the hearing if they choose not to attend. Failure to do so will result in the following fines:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing \$100 fine • Failure to appear at a Conduct Board Hearing \$200 fine

For each violation, a letter will be mailed to a Parent/Guardian unless the student is over the age of 21 or financially independent.

Office of Student Conduct correspondence is delivered via IUP e-mail accounts. Failure to read e-mail will not be accepted as a reason to appeal a student conduct outcome.
