This course is being crosslisted as RGPL 440 -- it is already listed in the catalog as GEOG 440. The "(Also offered as RGPL . . .)" is being added to the Geography description.

3. Rationale for Changes:

The rationale for crosslisting Conservation: Environmental Analysis is that the course is a track course for students who have a Regional Planning major with an Environmental emphasis. We feel that it would be advantageous for Regional Planning students to be able to register for courses within their program that are listed as RGPL rather than GEOG. The crosslisting will also enable faculty in the department to correctly designate their course teaching load within the planning program, for accreditation and other purposes.
