Part-II Description of Curriculum Change

1. Catalog Description

BTED101/COSC101/ IFMG101 Computer Literacy

Prerequisite: None (3c – 0l – 3cr)

An introductory course designed to provide students with a fundamental understanding of computers. The course familiarizes students with the interaction of computer hardware and software. Emphasis is placed on the application of microcomputers, the use of productivity software (word processing, spreadsheet management, file and database management, presentation graphics, web browsers, search strategies, and e-mail), and the social and ethical aspects of the impact of computers on society. (Does not count toward Computer Science major). Note: This course is cross listed as BTED and IFMG 101. Any of these courses may be substituted for each other and may be used interchangeably for D or F repeats but may not be counted for duplicate credit.

2. Summary of the proposed change(s)

Changing the course name from “Microbased Computer Literacy” to “Computer Literacy”. The prefix and the number will stay the same.

3. Justification/rationale for the change(s)

The course was called micro-based because we wanted to stress the new aspects of the microcomputer as it was new then. Now that microcomputers are ubiquitous and when you mention the word 'computer' that is what most people conjure up in their minds, we can change the name back to 'computer literacy' and we can discuss all computers in the course. The new name will be more appropriate than still calling it micro-based.
