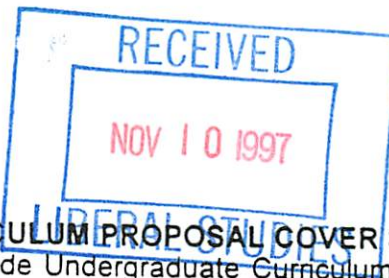

Part II: Course prefix change from HE to FC

The following standing course will continue to be offered under the HE prefix and will also be offered under the FC prefix:

FC 482 Independent Study

var.-1-3sh

Prerequisite: Prior approval through advisor, faculty member, department chairperson, dean, and provost's office

Upper-level students with high scholastic achievement pursue their particular interests outside the realm of the organized family and consumer sciences education curriculum. May be taken more than once to a maximum of 3 semester hours. Approval is based on academic appropriateness and availability of resources.

Part III: Rationale for Change

These changes will align the course prefix and descriptions with the recent program name change. The current program title is Family and Consumer Sciences Education, formerly Home Economics Education. Please note, these changes effect only those courses that are exclusively Family and Consumer Sciences Education courses. All other HE prefix courses will be changed through the Child Development/Family Relations program.
