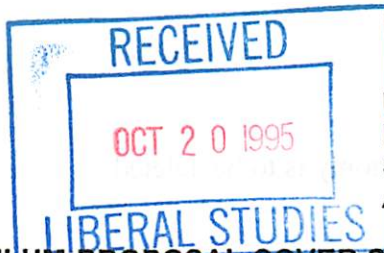

GS 110 General Astronomy is to be deleted.

Justification:

The Geoscience Department has revised GS 110 General Astronomy into part of its new sequence of courses GS 101-106 Introduction to Geoscience. The course sequence GS 105-106 Exploring the Universe, taken either as a lab science course, or GS 105 lecture only will permit students to take an introductory course in astronomy.

Effects of change:

The change does not affect any student in any particular program inasmuch as GS 110 is not required in any program. Students who did take GS 110 in partial fulfillment of their Liberal Studies non-lab science option may take GS 105. We expect that GS 105 will be offered once a year, at least.
