**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED REVISIONS**

**Undergraduate Catalog - Requirements for Bachelor of Arts-Spanish**

We are not proposing a major program revision. We already did that and it was approved in 1991. We are fine tuning that revision in the following way:

Change the "Requirements for Bachelor of Arts - Spanish"

From:

At least one course from those numbered 410-431	3sh
Any other nine (9) credits in courses 342 or above	9sh

To:

At least two courses from those numbered 410-431	6sh
Any other six (6) credits in courses 342 or above	6sh

**RATIONALE FOR REVISION**

**Undergraduate Catalog - Requirements for Bachelor of Arts-Spanish**

Under the current program students have opted not to take more than one 400 level literature course. The Bachelor of Arts degree in Spanish is a Liberal Arts degree. Literature courses are at the very heart of this program. This proposed change will give greater credibility to the Bachelor of Arts degree by requiring that students take at least two senior level Hispanic literature courses. The Spanish for International Trade and the Spanish for Secondary Education programs will not be affected by this change.
