The proposed change removes two courses (MG 311 Human Behavior in Organization and QB/MG 360 Management and Production Concepts) from the replaces them with two new courses (MG 310 Principles of management and MG 330 Production and Operations Management).

This change in the business administration core is necessitated due to the deletion of QB/MG:360 Management and Production Concepts. This course essentially covered the twin areas of Management and Production. Two new proposed courses — MG 310 Principles of Management and MG 330 Production & Operations Management — will now cover the two areas. Production and operations management is an area which has grown in importance. The new courses will allow us to cover production management area more adequately and give it the emphasis that it deserves.
