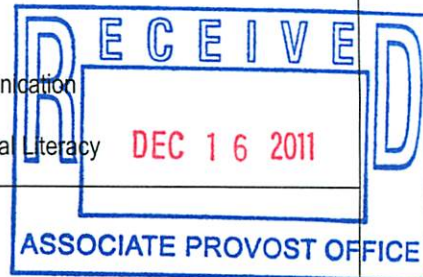

**Part II.**

1. **Description of what is to be deleted:** All catalog text referring to the Bachelor of Arts—Spanish for International Trade program should be deleted.
2. **Justification:** The B.A. in Spanish for International Trade has had a low number of students in it for the past few years. Furthermore, due to retirements, the Department has lost the professors that taught the specialized language courses unique to this major. The Department of Foreign Languages recognizes the need to eliminate this program in order to apply resources elsewhere.
3. **Effects of deletion:** The deletion of the B.A. in Spanish for International Trade is not expected to have any significant effect on other courses or programs, but the deletion will affect some students currently in the program.

There are seven students in the program, five seniors and two sophomores. The following is the “teach-out plan” for those students. For all of the students in the major, the Department of Foreign Languages will allow them to take SPAN 220 Intermediate Spanish Conversation as a substitute for SPAN 222 Intermediate Spanish Conversation and Grammar—Business, since the latter has not been offered in the past few years. The only other Spanish course that is specific to this major is SPAN 354 Commercial Spanish, and the course has not been offered recently due to low enrollments and the retirement of professors who taught it. The two sophomores and three of the seniors have not yet taken SPAN 354. The Department will allow them to take any 3-credit 300-level or 400-level Spanish course as a substitute for SPAN 354, so that the students may have the required number of credits and may continue to build their language proficiency.
