ART EDUCATION PROGRAM CHANGES for FALL 2012:

The Art Department is proposing the following changes in the Art Education program in light of the new Liberal Studies requirements:

- (1) We will have students take **7 credits of science**
- (2) All education majors have to take 6 credits of Mathematics. (This is not new, just a change of where these credits are placed in our curriculum categories.
- (3) **ARHI 207: Renaissance to Modern Art** will be our Liberal Studies elective. (It was approved as a Liberal Studies elective some years ago).
- (4) We will add **EDEX 323** as a state and IUP Special Education requirement
- (5) We were granted up to 126 credits by the PASSHE system as a special dispensation. We would like to keep our program at 125 credits, adding **3 credits of an Art Studio or Art History elective** to replace Senior Synthesis. Since our program was reduced to 126 or under credits, students are not getting as much content background as we would like.
