ELIGIBILITY:

*Student must reside in one of the following counties: Cumberland, Dauphin, York, Franklin, Juniata, Mifflin or Perry

*Must be a full-time student at one of the 14 Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education Universities

*Student must show academic promise by maintaining a 3.0 GPA or better

*Student must have a major in a healthcare related field (including biology and healthcare informatics)

*Student must be a junior or a senior

Summer School 2013

When the NAHP Department offers summer nursing courses that are part of the required undergraduate nursing curriculum, they are condensed. Intensive study is required of all students taking these courses. To facilitate academic success in these select courses, the following guidelines will be followed to determine student eligibility for course enrollment:

1. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 at time of registration to meet summer nursing course eligibility requirement. **
2. When students have earned less than a “C” grade in a nursing course and are registering to repeat the course, they are not guaranteed a seat in the class until all students who are taking the course for the first time have enrolled/registered and an opening still exists.
3. Students wanting to take a summer nursing course must “preregister” in the NAHP Department office by April 15th.
4. Each summer nursing course will have a set limit for minimum and/or maximum enrollment size. No class seats are reserved or held for any student.
5. The cumulative GPA will be used to prioritize students for placement in the course; (highest cumulative GPA gets priority seating).
6. All necessary prerequisite courses must have been completed successfully prior to taking a summer nursing course(s) and all co-requisite courses must be scheduled and taken during the same summer as the nursing course (s).

** Students registering for 4 credits or less do not need to meet the 3.00 cumulative GPA guideline, but do need to meet the course(s) prerequisites and co-requisites.

The Nurse Candidate Program (NCP)

The NCP provides a monthly stipend for full time students in accredited Bachelor of Science Nursing programs. Students can enroll after their sophomore year and receive an initial grant of \$10,000 (paid in installments of \$5,000 each), plus \$1,000 a month for up to 24 months.

After graduation, participants join the Navy Nurse Corps as an Officer, with the opportunity to earn a competitive salary, promotions, comprehensive medical and dental coverage, low cost travel opportunities, excellent retirement and educational benefits, further training, and a rewarding clinical practice. Additional benefits include 30 days of paid vacation per year, use of military recreational facilities around the world, the opportunity to serve around the world in a variety of facilities, and to be a part of a supportive team of highly trained professionals.
