PLSC 357 Labor and Business in Politics, PLSC 380 Soviet Politics, PLSC 386 Atlantic Community, and PLSC 444 Science/Tech and Publi [sic].

2. Rationale

The most recently any of these courses has been offered is 1995 and they are unlikely to be offered in the future. Deletion is part of the associated revision of two major tracks in Political Science and a change in the catalog copy.

3. How does this affect courses, programs, current students, etc.?

Because of their antiquity, deletion of these courses affects none of the above.
