

EDSP 813 Assessment for Intervention II (3 credits)

The intent of this course is to provide the student with skills necessary to administer and interpret informal, developmental, perceptual-motor, adaptive, achievement, and other allied measures used in a psycho-educational assessment. Moreover, students should become aware of issues associated with individualizing assessments based upon variables such as ethnicity, SES, gender, medical conditions, and linguistic and cultural differences.

Prerequisite: For approved school psychology candidates or permission of instructor.
