

**EDSP 818 Instructional Consultation (3 credits)**

This course reviews the basic principles of the consultative process as applied to working with teachers and school-based problem-solving teams to help students with academic problems. Students will be expected to demonstrate skill in consultative interviewing regarding academic problems, problem identification, data-gathering relevant to both curriculum and the classroom environment, and intervention design, execution, and evaluation in pre-kindergarten through high school settings.

Prerequisites: For approved school psychology candidates; must have taken or take concurrent with EDSP 812 (previously EDSP 712) and EDSP 813 (previously 713); permission of instructor.
