

CACREP Counseling Program/Student Outcomes

Clinical Mental Health Counseling (Community Counseling)

Currently, IUP has 105 students enrolled in the Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program (CACREP accredited under the title Community Counseling). Last year, there were 24 graduates from this program. Our students consistently score well on the National Counseling Exam (NCE). Our 2013 pass rate on the NCE was 90%.

Of the admitted students for the IUP Indiana campus, 80% graduated from the program in the expected time period. Of the admitted students for the IUP Penn Center campus, 88% graduated from the program in the expected time period. Therefore, the combined completion rate is 84%. 92% of program graduates responding to surveys who are actively seeking jobs are employed.

School Counseling

Currently, IUP has 55 students enrolled in the School Counseling Program. Last year, there were 28 graduates from this program. Our students consistently score exceptionally well on the School Counseling Praxis exam. Our 2013 pass rate on the Praxis exam was 100%.

Of the admitted students for the IUP Indiana campus, 73% graduated from the program in the expected time period. Of the admitted students for the IUP Penn Center campus, 75% graduated from the program in the expected time period. Therefore, the combined completion rate is 74%. 84% of program graduates responding to surveys who are actively seeking jobs are employed.
