Your Options through The Haven Project

The Alice Paul House

- * **Offers crisis intervention**—through a confidential 24-hour hotline to answer questions, address safety issues, offer shelter, and provide information and referral to other campus and community agencies.
- * **Helps survivors with the criminal justice system**—by educating survivors about the system, accompanying survivors in filing criminal charges, assisting students in obtaining a Protection From Abuse order, and preparing a Victim Impact Statement.
- * **Accompanies and provides support to survivors seeking medical services**—at local medical facilities, including IUP's Health Service, and Indiana Regional Medical Center.

The Haven Project

- * **Assists survivors through the IUP Student Conduct process**—by educating survivors on the process, assisting survivors with filing Student Conduct charges, and/or accompanying survivors to Student Conduct proceedings.
- * **Assists survivors with their safety and well-being**—by helping with new university housing assignments, rearranging class schedules, obtaining coursework extensions, obtaining withdrawals from courses, and safety planning.
- * **Offers confidential counseling**—including individual and/or group counseling provided at IUP's Counseling Center.

The Alice Paul House and the Haven Project collaborate to meet students' needs. Some services overlap.
