Dear Phil,

The University-wide Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (UWUCC) received a request to develop a shortened way to change the BIOL requirement in all of the programs and courses that currently list BIOL 103 or BIOL 103-104 as either a Natural Science requirement or as a prerequisite for a course. The Biology Department now has three courses to choose from BIOL 103 Life on Earth, BIOL 104 Human Biology: How the Human Body Works and BIOL 106 Human Genetics and Health (see catalog descriptions below). Your program(s) and/or course(s) listed below have been identified as currently listing BIOL 103 and/or BIOL 104 as either required or recommended.

The University Senate has approved the UWUCC decision that the departments involved just needed to let UWUCC know which course(s) you would now like to see listed in your program or course via an email. Then we would approve that change and forward it to Senate and from the Senate Agenda the catalog editor will be able to revise your listing. This is just a special case to deal quickly with the impacts of the revised BIOL Natural Science sequence.
