Comments for UWUCC for Provisional Approval:

The LS Committee is concerned that the Outcomes are too intensive for a 100 level course. For example, Outcome 10 "Synthesize conclusions ..." might be rewritten to: "students will be required to draw connections between history and culture, and among people of African descent across time and/or space." This goal is simpler, easier to accomplish, less abstract and less ambitious and might be better fitted to the 100 level nature of the course.
