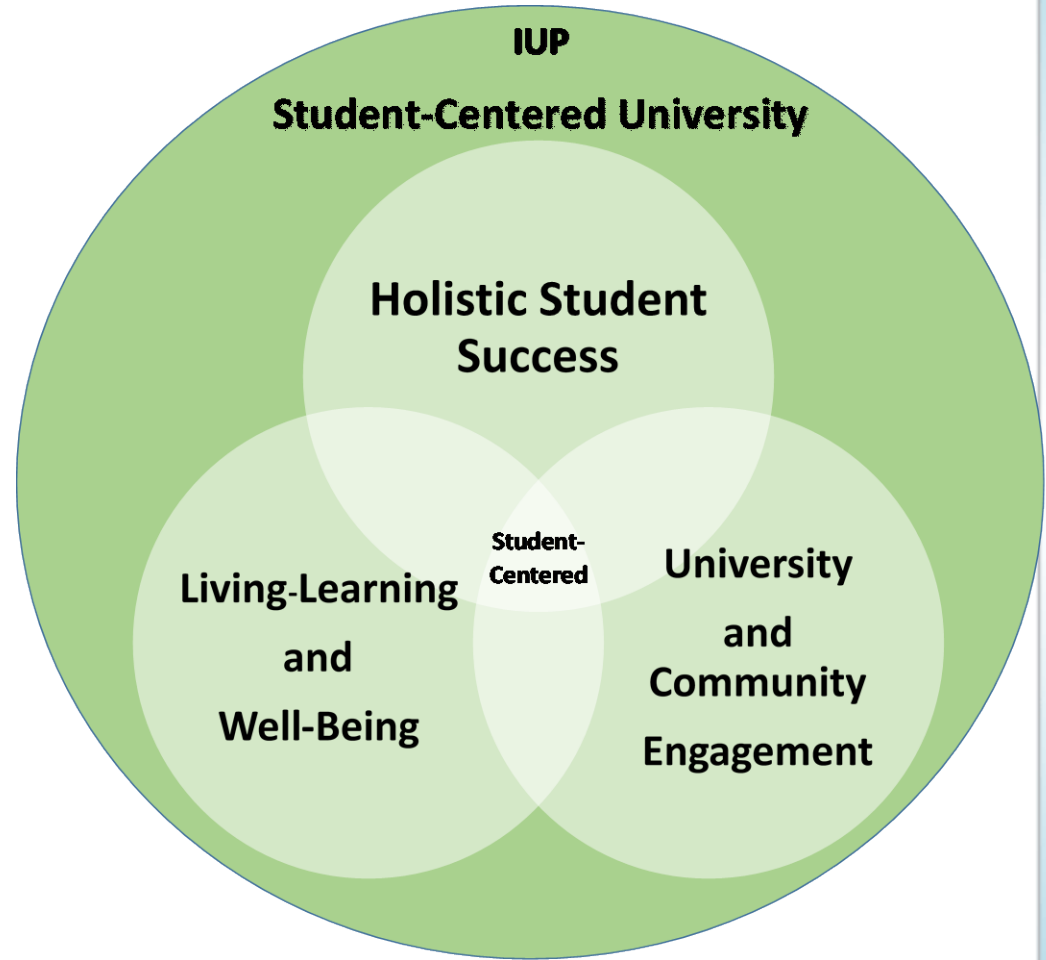

The Center for Multicultural Student Leadership & Engagement (MCSLE)

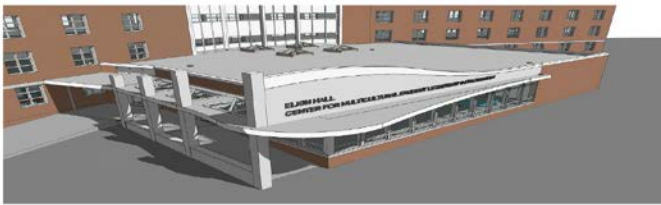


Four offices which comprise MCSLE:

- Program Coordination, Communication, & Assessment



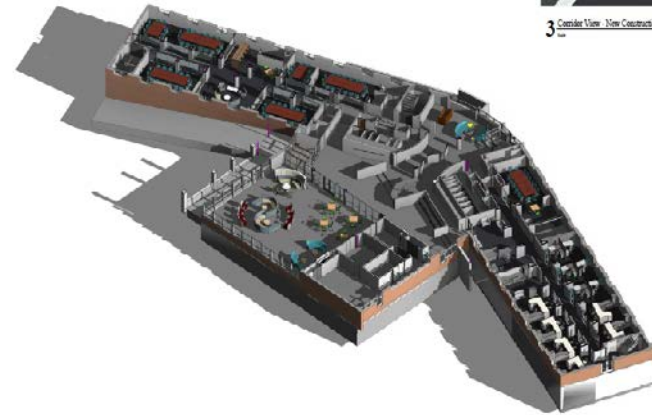
MCSLE Location
