Curriculum

- Change of Liberal Studies Requirement for tracks in Management Department program revision.
 - **Under Section A Why is the course being revised/deleted?**
Change the wording from “We want to limit the third social science...” to language that takes out the word “limit” and instead include language that states they want to encourage students to consider taking courses that meet the GMA requirement while fulfill their social science requirements.
 - **Under Section B University Senate Summary of Rationale**
Include an additional sentence that states this addition is to provide assistance to advisors when recommending Social Science courses to students.
 - **Under Proposed Catalog Description**
Include the word **recommend** and the word **and**
Social Sciences: ECON 121, PSYC 101, and **recommend** a course that also fulfills the Global **and** Multicultural Awareness requirement.
 - **Motion to recommend PROVISIONAL APPROVAL of Changes of Liberal Studies Requirement was carried.**

- RLST 120 Comparative Religious Studies New Course: Liberal Studies Knowledge Area—Humanities Religious Studies and Global and Multicultural Awareness. Also requesting Liberal Studies Elective-Global Citizenship
 - Remove from the Liberal Studies Elective-Global Citizenship category. We typically allow courses to only fulfill one category: Knowledge Area or Liberal Studies Electives.
 - **Under Section Q Why is the Course being Proposed? and Section R University Senate Summary of Rationale**
Include a line that explains why this course fulfills Global and Multicultural Awareness. (The LSC agrees that the committee fulfills the requirement, we just need it to be written out in the rationale.)
 - Correct type in **Section P Brief Course Outline** Roman Numeral III fix spelling of Gandhi.
 - **Motion to recommend PROVISIONAL APPROVAL of RLST 120 was carried.**
