EDUC 242 must be taken and completed before taking EDUC 342. 8 credit two lab sciences - must be in a series. *To student teach, students (admitted to teacher education after January 23, 2001) must have the cumulative GPA required at the time of their admittance and a 2.75 GPA in their social science major courses. Freshman entering in Fall 2002 will be required to have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and a 3.0 GPA in their social science major course to student teach. *Fall 2002 - HIST 204 and HIST 205 will replace HIST 203 and one 300+ course. New option - take one HIST 400-404 topics course or HIST 480 Senior Seminar. Students beginning Fall 2003 are not required to take FDED 102.
