Additional Notes:

- Suggested that the 1 credit free electives include LIBR 151 or ELED 110 to be taken during the first two semesters at IUP.
- Students will be required to take a Non-Western Cultures course if the courses taken in Geography and Social Science electives do not fulfill this requirement. Some Non-Western Cultures courses can count as liberal studies electives.
- A 3.0 cumulative QPA is required to apply for teacher certification.
- Students must acquire 48 credits by the end of semester three to be eligible for admission to Teacher Education and Professional Sequence I.
- Application for Professional Sequence I and Professional Sequence II will occur at an important meeting at about week eight of the semester prior to your enrollment in the courses. Without completing an application you cannot participate in the Professional Sequence I and Professional Sequence II program.
- ELED 425 (Language Arts) cannot be taken until the prerequisite ELED 222 (Reading) is completed and ELED 425 must be completed before taking Professional Sequence II.
- It is required that at least three of the four sciences and ELED 313 (Math) be completed before taking Professional Sequence II.
