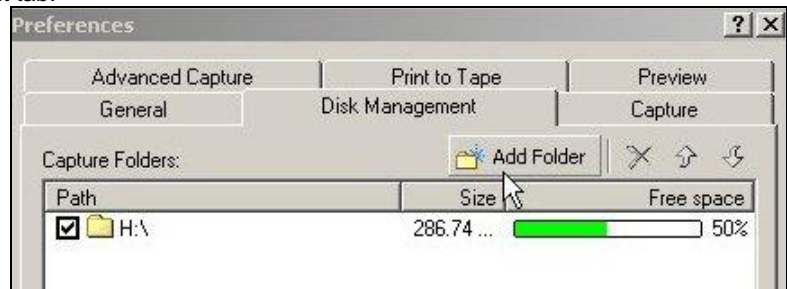

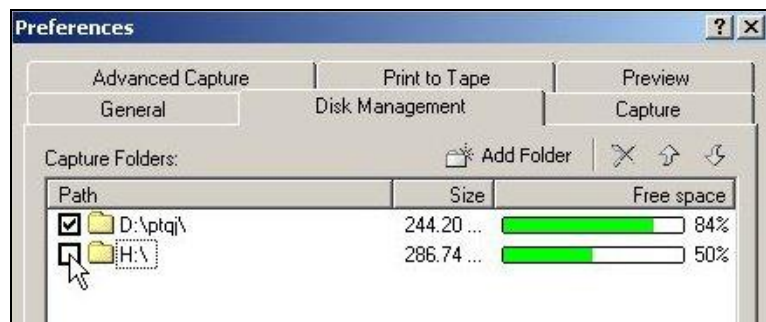
Capturing my Project

How do I put the video camera footage on the computer?

1. Connect your camera using RCA jacks on the VCR deck or the Fire Wire port coming from the computer.
2. Press *Play* on the camera.
3. Open *Sony*, then *Vegas*
4. In *File*, select *Capture Video*.
5. A new window will appear for capturing. Before you can go any further, set up your Capture folder. Click on *Options*, then *Preferences*. Then click on the *Disk Management* tab.
6. Click on *Add Folder*. Then locate your personal folder on the *Data (D:)* drive.

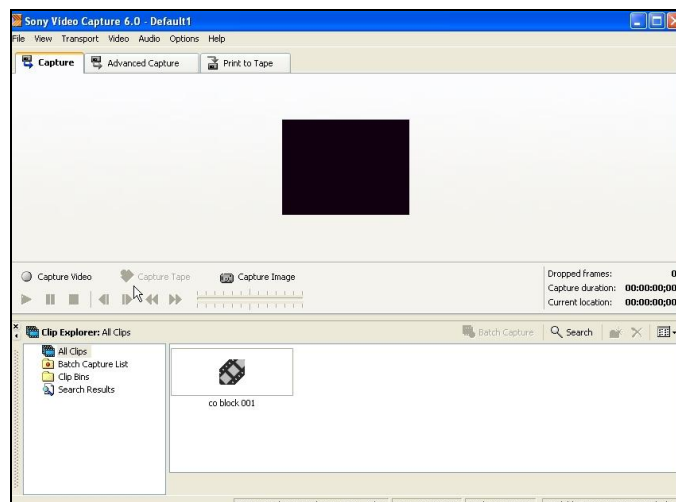


7. Then deselect the *H:* drive folder, but make sure your personal folder is selected. Click *Apply*, then *OK*. You are now ready to capture video.



8. Now cue your video tape to where you want to start capturing.

9. Another window will appear. You will see your video playing.
10. Make sure you can hear the sound playing through the headphones.



11. On the middle left hand side of the capture window, there will be a radial button, "Capture Video". Click this button once when you want to start capturing. Click on the blue/black square when you want to stop capturing.



Note* Pay attention to the number of dropped frames that occur. If you have more than 5 dropped frames in one minute, you have to stop and recapture.

Note** Dropped frames WILL occur when you are surfing the internet, playing video games, or downloading other programs at the same time as capturing. Other causes of dropped frames are from the tape being damaged or the video tracking is poor.
