Workstation Configurations

Minimum Standards for Fall 2000

Approved at the March 20, 2000 ACPAC meeting

For Fall 2000, the minimum workstation should be able to run the standard software which includes Windows98, Office2000, a graphical internet browser, and a graphical e-mail client. Recommendations for a new purchase workstation will be determined during late summer 2000. These recommended minimum configurations are proposed based upon the expected funding model approved by the TUC and endorsed by the Provost. This funding model requires that the distribution of ESF funds be prorated by the number of teaching faculty positions within each college and that an inventory of faculty PCs be made public. It is expected that this funding stream should allow a 3 year replacement cycle for all faculty PCs.
