Workshop Opportunity Focusing on Collaborative On-line Learning

The CORAL (Collaborative On-line Research and Learning) team is pleased to offer a workshop to PA-SSHE faculty to demonstrate this distance teaching/learning model. CORAL is a student-centered teaching method that uses technology to facilitate collaboration between universities. Students from two universities form teams (learning communities) across sites working together on semester-long assignments. The projects are relevant to, and integrate topics from, the courses being taught at the two universities. This teaching method, therefore, encourages intraand inter-disciplinary teaching/learning.

Students use web-based discussion boards, video conferencing, file managers, chat rooms, on-line calendars, and email to communicate with their teammates across and within sites. Peer project guides, students who have previously taken a CORAL course, serve as mentors to those currently enrolled in the CORAL course.
