



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARTICIPANT

It is expected that all participants in any University or non-University sponsored program, activity, or service will conduct themselves in a polite, respectful manner and will adhere to all University rules as follows.

1. The possession or use of alcohol and other drugs, fireworks, guns and weapons are prohibited.
2. Smoking of any kind (cigarettes, marijuana, vape, etc.) is prohibited in all University buildings.
3. The use of skateboards is prohibited.
4. No violence, including sexual abuse or harassment, will be tolerated.
5. Hazing, bullying, and cyber bullying will not be tolerated.
6. All curfews, if applicable, will be followed.
7. Curfews will include: (1) be in the residence hall by 10:00 PM until morning and (2) be in assigned room by 12:00 AM until morning (exceptions for seeking counselor support).
8. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM – 7:00 AM each day. During quiet hours, all noise (to include music, TV, socializing, etc.) will be kept to a minimum so as not to be heard outside the room. Socializing may take place in lounges, but not in areas such as hallways where others may be disturbed.
9. Misuse or damage of University property is prohibited.
10. All minors will be accompanied by another minor at all times. This is the buddy system.
11. Participants in an overnight program are not permitted to be housed in the same room with an adult unless the person is the minor's parent or legal guardian.
12. Minor participants may only be housed with a participant of the same sex.
13. No minor will be housed in a room alone.
14. The inappropriate use of cameras, imaging, and digital devices is prohibited including use of such devices in showers, restrooms, or other areas where privacy is expected by participants.
15. Profanity is prohibited.
16. When crossing streets, only cross in the designated crosswalks.
17. Only use the building designated by your program supervisor or staff.
18. If you are hurt or injured, immediately report your injury to the program supervisor or staff.
19. All standard IUP Policies are in effect.
