Opportunities while Enrolled

 internships are paid and result in full-time job offers. Our Corporate Relations Office in Eberly
 and departmental internship coordinators, and faculty advisors assist students to obtain
 internships and career placement.
- Students are encouraged to join the **Student Accounting Association** (SAA) which organizes field trips to companies, invites accounting professionals to speak at its bi-weekly meetings and attend its annual Accounting Career Day in Fall and Recognition Dinner in Spring. Last year 167 professionals from 81 companies participated in these SAA events which enabled our accounting majors to learn, grow, and expand their professional network.
