<u>It's On Us (to Stop Sexual Assault)</u>

It's On Us is to build the movement to combat campus sexual assault by engaging all students, including young men, and activating the largest student organizing program of its kind in grassroots awareness and prevention education programs. It's On Us was founded in 2014 as an initiative of the Obama-Biden White House to address the impact of sexual violence on college campuses—13% of all students experience rape or sexual assault through physical force, violence, or incapacitation (among all graduate and undergraduate students). The social movement has over 300,000 people taking the pledge to end sexual violence. Sources: It's On Us and RAINN

It's on Us to...

- Recognize that non-consensual sex is sexual assault.
- Identify situations in which sexual assault may occur.
- Intervene in situations where consent has not been given.
- Create an environment in which sexual assault is unacceptable and survivors are supported.
