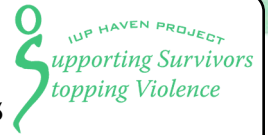

Green Dot: Bystander Intervention

Green Dot is a program aimed to **prevent dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking**. It explains different ways individuals can make a difference by **intervening** in a potentially violent situation. If everyone does their small part, the combined effect is a safe campus culture that is **intolerant of violence**.
