Minutes Approval

- Approval of minutes of the last meeting held 8/24/2022 (minutes file was sent by email).

Announcements:

- The fully executed grant was recently received by IUP and its effective date is 9/12/2022.
- Given that delay, I have secured the approval of the IUP Vice President for Finances to submit the scholarship tuition waiver forms for all students before the grant was award.
- Tuition/fees waivers were submitted on Aug. 30, 2022 and should have been processed by the Bursar's Office a while ago. **All, please confirm.**
- Students have been using the Coop Accounts set by the PI to buy their academic books this semester (with the exception of a couple of cases). If you still need to purchase any other books from the COOP, you need to do that ASAP.
- Right after the award of the grant on 9/12/2022, the PI has submitted requests to disburse scholarship stipends on the NextGen System (\$13,500 to each student for each semester). These requests should had been processed a while ago and each of you should had received her/his stipend. **All, please confirm.**
- Regarding the computer purchase and as we agreed, the best and fastest way to acquire these is for NEW CySP recipients to purchase her/his favorite laptop/desktop then we will reimburse you for your expenses (up to \$1,500). **The following information** needs to be submitted to me to initiate the processing of your reimbursement. So far, Jordan and Malcolm are the only two who sent me this info. All other NEW students, please do that ASAP. **Any questions??**

 - **Address to which check should be mailed**
 - **Proof of purchase (invoice with payment method shown)**
- There is one upcoming major cybersecurity event at IUP and **ALL CySP recipients are strongly encouraged and expected to participate in this event:**

- In addition, this Friday Sept. 23, an international delegation consists of 17 cybersecurity professionals from about 10 different countries are visiting IUP to know more about our

projects and activities in the cybersecurity area. This delegation is sponsored by the US Department of State and is visiting IUP for the first time. If any one of you would like to join this (from 10:30 AM – 12:00 noon), please let me know ASAP.

- **Health Insurance Coverage.** Based on our discussion last meeting, no one showed interest in the possible health insurance coverage. **Every recipient needs to officially opt in or out of this benefit in this meeting. Please record the response of each student.**

 - Participating in Cyber Competition and/or Hackathon such as the CAE NCX, NSA Code Breaker, etc.
 - Involvement into research projects with project Co-PIs.
 - Actively participating in the peer-mentoring program, see also below.
