- All six CSA returning students, please confirm that you will submit your renewal application via AVUE tool by the Feb. 1st deadline. The grant PI reminded all students with the following and also sent several email reminders.
 - Part of returning application is a required Letter of Support (LoS) that will be written by me. If you have not email me your updated resume, please do so ASAP so I'll be able to complete this letter and send it to you before the deadline.
 - Please remember that the deadline is Feb. 1.
 - You will be using the same tool you used last year, make sure you have access to it and start your application ASAP.

- The other SEVEN graduating students, please confirm that ALL your graduation requirements will be fulfilled this semester, and you will be able to graduate this May.
- All students, please confirm the exact # of credits you registered for this spring and confirm that no changes to these figures will happen. Dr. Farag will then submit scholarship tuition waiver forms for all students to the Bursar's Office. Credits should be reflected on your Easy Pay accounts once these forms are processed which can take some time.
- As announced before, you should be able to use the created IUP bookstore accounts at the Coop for Spring 2025 required textbooks up to your \$500 allowance.
- After about one month into the spring, these accounts will be closed so that we can assess if the leftover balance for each one may be used or not. We will discuss updates at the next meeting.
- The PI has used the Next Gen System (IUP scholarship management system) to assign a \$14,500 stipend to each one of you in Spring 2025. Please confirm the receipt of your spring stipend.
