Allergy injections are available at the Health Service. Students that would like to have their allergy shots administered by the Health Service staff must submit the following information before they can receive their injection at the Health Service.

## **ALLERGY INJECTION REQUIREMENTS**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Initial (very first) allergy injection must be given by allergist.
- \_\_\_\_\_Allergist name, address, phone and fax number.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Current, precise, written instructions from prescribing allergist Signed by the allergist.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Schedule of administration.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Dose/volume of serum to be administered.
- \_\_\_\_ Vial of serum.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Concentration and vaccine contents.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Expiration date of serum.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Specific instructions for missed injections.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Instructions for local and systemic reactions.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Date and amount of last injection and reaction.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Health Service Consent letter signed by allergist.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Student Allergy Clinic Agreement signed by student.

\_\_\_\_\_Appointment with Health Service Physician (Any new Allergy Clinic students or returning students that have new immunotherapy started)
