II B. Course Revisions:

The committee discussed what would be the best way to have course proposers deal with the common learning objectives listed in each criteria for the new LS curriculum. The LS committee feels that the college curriculum committees should be responsible for determining whether these objectives are met or not. The LSC feels that the college curriculum committees should review the course and state whether or not they are satisfied that the Common Learning Outcomes listed under the criteria for each LS category are met by this course. We think that a form needs to be created to add to the UWUCC handbook that would then be attached to the cover sheet/proposal. We would also need to update the handbook checklist for LS courses.

II. E. Catalog Revisions:
