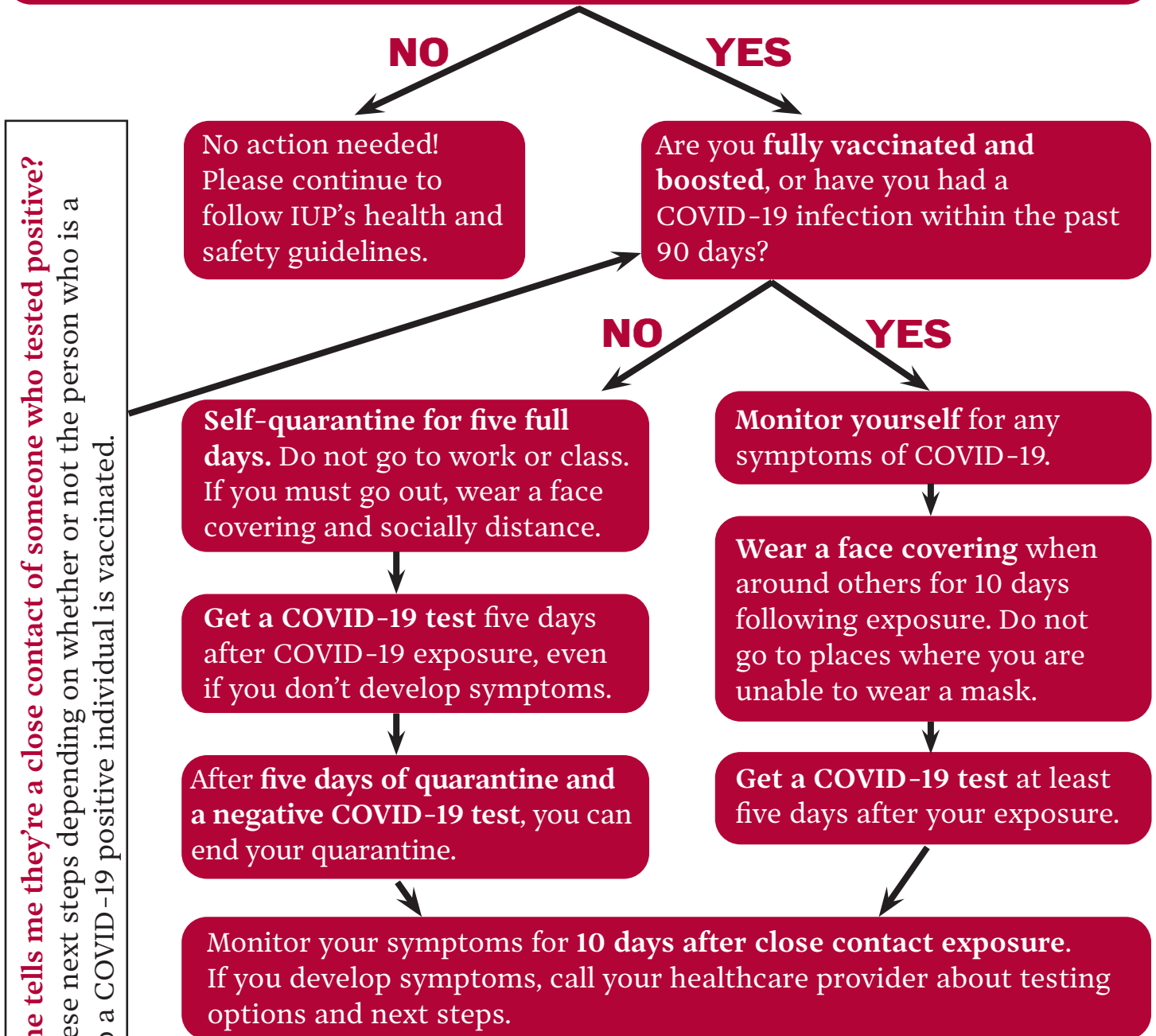


WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE YOU KNOW TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 AT IUP

Check yourself: were you a close contact? The CDC defines close contact as spending at least 15 minutes within six feet of the COVID-19 positive person over a 24-hour period.



What if someone tells me they're a close contact of someone who tested positive? Recommend these next steps depending on whether or not the person who is a close contact to a COVID-19 positive individual is vaccinated.

Contact Tracing at IUP

IUP students who have tested positive for COVID-19 will receive an email from IUP Covid Contacts Notification Process, asking for help in identifying close contacts. Close contacts identified by a COVID-19 positive student will receive an email advising them to contact IUP Health Service for instruction and additional testing.
