

Subject: File your 2020-21 FAFSA now: Federal CRRSAA funding may be available!

IUP has recently received funding from the U.S. Department of Education (USDE) under the CRRSAA Act (Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act).

It appears that you may be eligible to qualify for a CRRSAA funding because you are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, enrolled in at least one class in a financial aid eligible degree or certificate program during the spring semester. However, we have not yet received your **2020-21** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Funds are limited, but if you complete your **2020-21 FAFSA** online at <https://studentaid.gov> **on or before March 17, 2021**, we will gladly review your eligibility for these funds. ***Please note: While we cannot guarantee you will receive a grant, CRRSAA funds will be awarded until funds have been exhausted***

IMPORTANT: When you log into the FAFSA, please make sure that you select the **2020-2021** application.
