Remember....

- Employees must understand:
 - Methods of reporting emergencies
 - Evacuation procedures and designated emergency escape routes
 - The location of designated assembly areas
 - Procedures for critical operations
 - The process to account for personnel
 - Whom has been assigned rescue and medical duties
 - Persons to contact for questions about the plan

- Ensure exit paths and doorways remain unobstructed
- Maintain good housekeeping to limit the amount of combustible/flammable material in the workplace
- When using flammable liquids:
 - Only use approved metal safety containers or original manufacturer's containers for storage
 - o Practice good housekeeping
 - Keep containers closed when not in use
 - Store away from exits or passageways
 - Keep away from ignition sources
