PA OSHA CONSULTATION

Remember....

- Your company's site specific policies/procedures in the event of a fire.
- The types of fires could you have (flammable liquid, combustible solids, electrical, etc.)
- The types of fire extinguishers available onsite.
 - Fire Extinguishers should be appropriately matched to work environment
- The capabilities and limitations of those extinguishers
- If you have the slightest doubt about your ability to fight a fire....
 EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY!

PASS

- "P"ULL... Pull the pin. This will also break the tamper seal.
- o "A"IM... Aim low, pointing the extinguisher nozzle (or its horn or hose) at the base of the fire. (Note: Do not touch the plastic discharge horn on CO2 extinguishers, it gets very cold and may damage skin.)
- "S"QUEEZE... Squeeze the handle to release the extinguishing agent
- o "S"WEEP... Sweep from side to side at the base of the fire until it appears to be out. If it re-ignites repeat steps 2-4
